# In what area do you work in?

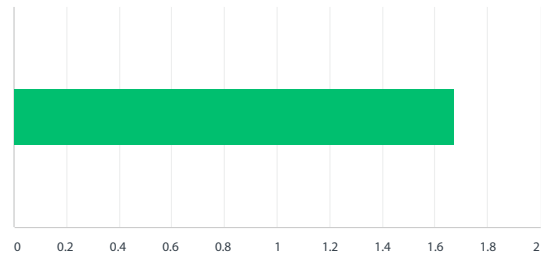

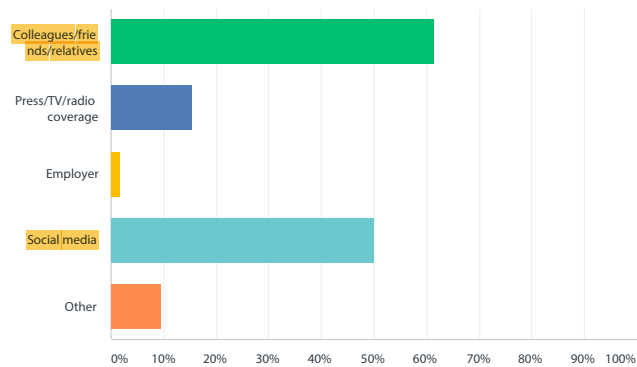

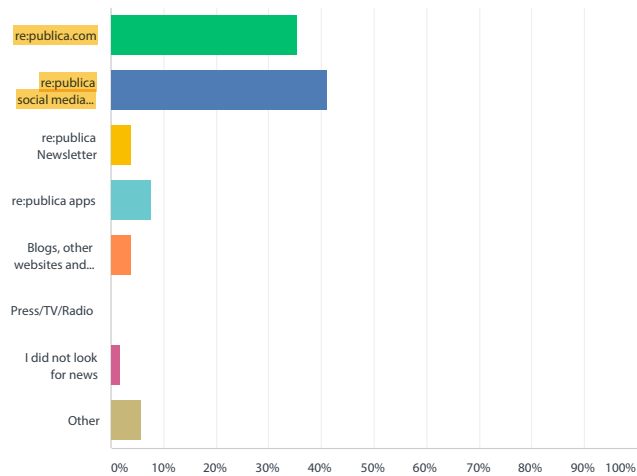

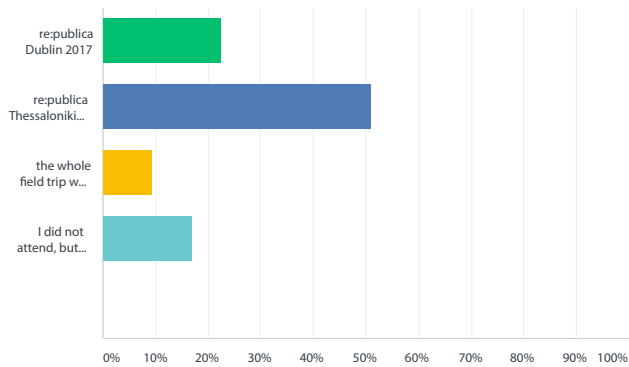

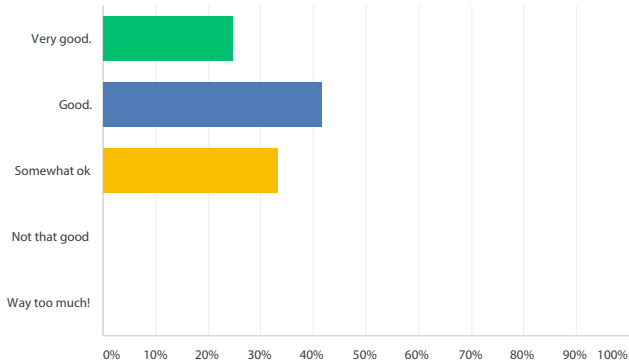
